

# Club Gazebo Bookings TTOM 2026

Here's everything you need to know about booking and paying for your club gazebo for the Totalsports Two Oceans Marathon 2026. Book and pay for your site early to avoid disappointment.

Club sites will once again be set up at **Middle Campus at the University of Cape Town, at the UCT Cricket Oval**. Runners can look forward to great food vendors, a beer garden and a great vibe.

## HOW TO BOOK

**Bookings are done online:** Book your gazebo via the [Race Entry System](#) or copy and paste <https://admin.twooceansmarathon.org.za/Identify.aspx> into your browser.

**Fee:** Gazebo sites are secured on a first-come, first-served basis at a cost of **R500 per gazebo, per day**. You must pay for your booking within **24 hours** to avoid forfeiting your selected site and having to make a new, different booking.

## IMPORTANT:

- **No alcohol may be brought onto the premises.**
- A designated, clearly marked entry and exit point will be managed by the event security team.
- Gazebo sites are **3m by 3m each**.

## SETTING UP BEFORE RACE DAY

- **Where:** Club gazebos sites are located at Middle Campus, UCT, on the Cricket Oval.
- **When:** All final info regarding setting up your site will be communicated once your booking has been confirmed.
- **Info point:** Please go to the clearly marked Information Office, conveniently housed in a dedicated container below the UCT Cricket Clubhouse.

## RACE DAY

The race ends – the ‘gees’ doesn’t! Here’s when you can set up your gazebo:

- **Access times on Saturday:** The UCT Middle Campus Cricket Oval area will be open from 5 AM – 3 PM. Kindly ensure your gazebo has been removed by 3 PM.
- **Access times on Sunday:** The UCT Middle Campus Cricket Oval area will be open from 5 AM – 1 PM. Kindly ensure your gazebo has been removed by 1 PM.

## ACCESS TO THE GAZEBOS ON FOOT FROM THE FINISH FIELD

To access the club gazebos from the finish field **on foot**, follow the signage from Upper Campus which will take you to the subway and down to the UCT Cricket Oval.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS – CLUB GAZEBO BOOKINGS TTOM 2026

Your Club Gazebo booking is subject to the following Terms and Conditions:

1. Everyone who accesses the club gazebo area must abide by all the rules as well as the access control and compliance measures which have been put in place to ensure the safety of all runners and spectators.
2. No booking, no site. Only clubs with pre-booked and paid sites will be allowed access to the designated sites.

3. The Race Organisers reserve the right to move club-allocated sites should this be necessary following mandatory site inspections with SAPS and Disaster Risk Management.
4. Any and all instructions from the Safety Officer or Venue Manager to take down / drop gazebos must be complied with. This may be requested in the event of adverse weather conditions.
5. Clubs may only set up their gazebos within their allocated sites as paid for and demarcated.
6. **No club vehicles** are allowed onto the club gazebo area. Please carry your gazebos to your designated, booked sites.
7. Gazebos dropped on 10 April must remain down until the next morning due to concern with the wind.
8. Clubs are responsible for the safety of their gazebos, club property and the property of club members. The Race Organisers take no responsibility for any loss or damage, including during build-up and strike-down days.
9. Clubs are not permitted to handle, move or dismantle gazebos not belonging to them in order to gain improved positioning.
10. Clubs may not cause any damage to the site area or surrounds in the club gazebo area at Middle Campus, UCT.
11. No gazebos may be left unattended once erected due to safety concerns (e.g. strong gusts of wind or other adverse weather conditions).
12. **Open fires, gas braais, skottels,** and **gas cylinders** are **not allowed** due to fire and safety regulations.
13. Camping is not permitted on the UCT fields and/or extended and/or adjacent property or properties.

14. No alcohol may be brought onto Middle Campus. This rule will be strictly enforced by the South African Police Services and event security throughout the day.
15. Club gazebos must not exceed 3m by 3m and must be free-standing. No anchor ropes may extend outside of the demarcated site areas.
16. All gazebos must be firmly secured with anchor ropes. Race organisers, venue managers and event security personnel may ask clubs who have not secured their gazebos with the appropriate ropes to take down their gazebos.
17. No platforms, scaffolding or sponsor signage may be used at club gazebo sites.
18. The Totalsports Two Oceans Marathon is committed to adhering to environmental by-laws and the event's eco-sustainability practices. No littering or water wastage will be tolerated. Clubs are required to use the bins provided.
19. Bins will be provided in the area. The TOM NPC requests that the entire area be kept strictly litter-free.
